This technology produces films that spectacularly and emotively describe a place, an urban project, a city, a historic or contemporary district, or even one yet imagined.

The video projections, warped perspectively by the three-dimensional surface of the model, create photorealistic textures or geometric highlights directly on the volumes' surfaces, including diagrams, lighting, information, or a complex digital texture.

Panoramic full-HD and higher quality video projections, compatible with the model's dimensional ratio, display layers, graphics, titles, numerical data, and other textual information on the scaled volumes, thus engagingly narrating the content to the audience.

The snowy and sculpted surface of the model is bathed in light, transforming into an electronic fabric, a dynamic digital environment. The soundtrack orchestrates the flow of images, shaping and animating objects that appear to float within the space, almost suspended.

A vertical digital sky can complete the setup, creating an unparalleled immersive environment.
